Welcome to the 2016-17 school year at Highland Presbyterian Church Nursery and Weekday School! We are excited about the coming year and eager to get things started.

We hope you will plan to participate in several important events:

<u>Home Visits:</u> All children will be visited at home by one of their teachers for 15 minutes prior to the first day of school. Your child's teacher will call you to arrange a time for this visit. The purpose of the visit is for your child to become acquainted with one of his/her teachers in familiar surroundings and so that he/she will have a familiar face when he/she arrives at school.

Family Fix-it Day on Saturday, August 13 from 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. This is a great time to get to know each other as we prepare for the start of school. Bring your gardening tools, and hand tools. We will spread mulch, repair some items that need attention and do some other general "sprucing up." We would love your help and your children are welcome to help, too.

Ice Cream Social, Sunday, August 21 from 4:00 - 5:00 p.m. Gather with us on the playground for an informal social event where both children and parents make new friends.

Parent Orientation, Thursday, August 25, from 7:00 - 9:00 p.m. (NO CHILDREN, PLEASE):

There will be opportunities to learn about the school policies and procedures, sign up for parent activities, and to attend a brief meeting with your child's teachers in the classroom. If your child's immunization record will expire before May 31, 2017, we will need an updated copy as soon as he/she receives his/her next round of vaccinations.

As you know, we offer the *optional* programs of Early and Extended Play in addition to our regular morning classes. Each of those programs offers additional time at Highland Pres. in a relaxed, play-based experience with a smaller group of children, often of varying ages. *Please review the enclosed sheet about the policies for our optional programs.* Both the Fall 2016 and September registration forms are enclosed. Please choose whichever best fits your family now. In the future, you will be able to download monthly forms and the Spring 2017 registration form from our website.

On the enclosed emergency cards there is a space for you to choose a 4 digit number that will be your security code. When you enter this number in the keypad on the front door it will allow you access to the building during school hours. NOTE: Returning families will use the same code as last year.
